

## **WATER TESTING INSTRUCTIONS**

- A. Adjust** total alkalinity 100 to 150 PPM. Use **Total Alkalinity Increaser** to raise total alkalinity. Use **PH -** to reduce alkalinity. Add only when test strip indicates.
- B. Maintain** PH 7.2 to 7.6. Use **PH Increaser** to increase; use **Lo'N Slo** to decrease. Read container for amounts. Add only when test strip indicates.
- C. Maintain** chlorine level 1 to 3 PPM (on test strip) with **Smart Sticks**. Use 1 Smart Stick per 5,000 gallons of water.

## **REGULAR MAINTENANCE**

### **A. Shocking Pool**

Shock pool with 1 gallon of **Super Shock** *or* 1 big bag of **Burn Out** *or* 2 lb. of **BioGuard Lite**, for every 10,000 gallons, every 2 weeks.

\*Note: When water gets warm and pool usage is high, shocking intervals may be more often.

### **B. Algaecide**

Add 2 oz. of **Algaecide** per 5,000 gallons every 2 weeks.

Do not add after shocking pool.

Keep **Smart Sticks** in the skimmer at the rate of 1 stick per 5,000 gallons.
