WATER TESTING INSTRUCTIONS

- **A. Adjust** total alkalinity 100 to 150 PPM. Use <u>Total Alkalinity Increaser</u> to raise total alkalinity. Use <u>PH -</u> to reduce alkalinity. Add only when test strip indicates.
- **B.** Maintain PH 7.2 to 7.6. Use <u>PH Increaser</u> to increase; use <u>Lo'N Slo</u> to decrease. Read container for amounts. Add only when test strip indicates.
- **C. Maintain** chlorine level 1 to 3 PPM (on test strip) with **Smart Sticks**. Use 1 Smart Stick per 5,000 gallons of water.

REGULAR MAINTENANCE

A. Shocking Pool

Shock pool with 1 gallon of <u>Super Shock</u> or 1 big bag of <u>Burn Out</u> or 2 lb. of <u>BioGuard Lite</u>, for every 10,000 gallons, every 2 weeks.

*Note: When water gets warm and pool usage is high, shocking intervals may be more often.

B. Algaecide

Add 2 oz. of Algaecide per 5,000 gallons every 2 weeks.

Do not add after shocking pool.

Keep **Smart Sticks** in the skimmer at the rate of 1 stick per 5,000 gallons.
